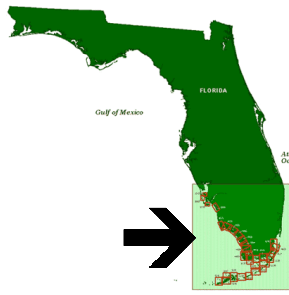


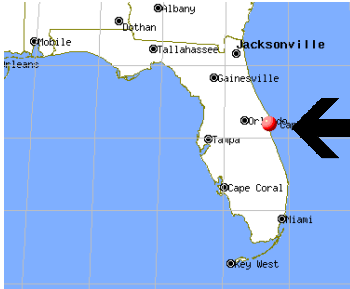
# Chapter 6 – A Boat and Bus Tour of the Southeast

- Florida
- A large swamp
- More than 300 kinds of birds
- Many kinds of animals – alligators, crocodiles, turtles, snakes, otters, and more

## Sun Belt



- Part of the United States from Florida to California
- A mild climate – usually warm and sunny

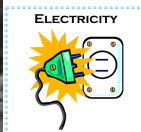


## Jamestown, Virginia

### New Orleans, Louisiana



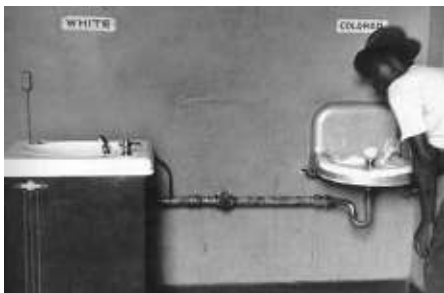
- Birthplace of Dixieland Jazz
  - o African American music
- Cajuns
  - o French colonists from Canada living in Louisiana
  - o Called themselves Acadians
  - o Known for hot, spicy food

### Petroleum



- Oil
- Used to make **petrochemicals**
  - o Chemicals made from oil
  - o Used to make many products from plastics to medicine
- Found in the Gulf of Mexico
  - o Under the ocean floor
  - o First build oil rigs to hold drilling machinery
  - o Second drill into the ocean floor to find oil

### Segregation



- Separation of people because of race and the color of your skin
- **Civil rights movement** began as a protest against segregation
